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Introduction to Philosophy: philosophical narrations

Aims of the course

The module in **Introduction to Philosophy** aims at giving a general historical and systematic outline of the Western philosophical thought. In this module, as first part of the annual philosophical course students will become familiar with concepts and authors which have become classic for this discipline. Most of all special attention will be paid to the modus operandi philosophy developed over the centuries and its forms of narrations.

Contents

This module will take into account philosophical narrations to underline the peculiarities of the discipline. A special focus will be shared on the meaning of "introducing philosophy".

Methodology

The course will mainly consist of reading and discussing.

The lecture of two hours (c.t.) will be divided in two parts. After an introductory presentation (with power point, pictures, short texts) a specific reading will be (re)read, analysed or commented. All the texts will be uploaded in pdf and shared before the lecture, in time to let everyone to be prepared for the collective discussion.

The final mark will be based on:

- 1. the quality of attendance, interest and participation (1-10)
- 2. final written test (usually the final day course) (1-10)
- 3. oral exam (1-10)
